

TPS Illness/COVID-19 Return to School Policy

1. Student or Staff has Mild Symptoms of Covid-19 but was NOT Tested

- o To return to school all three requirements must be met:
 - No fever in 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine)
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present
 - Doctor's note providing clearance to return to school

2. Student or Staff Tested Negative for Covid-19

- o To return to school all four requirements must be met:
 - No fever in 24 hours (without use of fever reducing medicine)
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present
 - Copy of PCR Covid-19 Result
 - Doctor's note providing clearance to return to school

3. Student or Staff Tested Positive for Covid-19

- o To return to school all five requirements must be met:
 - 10 days have passed since start of symptoms (10 days from date of positive test if no symptoms develop)
 - No fever in 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine)
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present
 - Copy of PCR Covid-19 Result
 - Doctor's note providing clearance to return to school

4. Student or Staff had Direct Exposure to a Person with Covid-19

- o To return to school all three requirements must be met:
 - Quarantined for 10 days from date of exposure
 - No fever in 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine)
 - No Covid-19 symptoms present

*All doctor's notes must clearly state cause of symptoms as per CDC guidelines

Symptoms of COVID-19 include: fever or chills (100.0 degrees F or greater), cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, extreme fatigue, muscle or body aches, unusual headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, unexplained rash, pinkeye.
